



2009 - 2010 Tour Instructions

- Attached is your Lucasi Hybrid All American Tour packet
- Enclosed is a schedule for all stops in 2009/2010
- If you owe any outstanding invoices from the 2008/2009 Tour, please remit immediately (invoice enclosed)
- If you have not submitted the forms already, please complete one “Sanctioned Tournament Application” for each stop you have scheduled, and remit immediately with \$25/event sanction fees.
- You will be emailed a copy of a flyer for your Tour stop(s) by the ACS (hard copies may be enclosed)
- Please make copies of flyers and distribute locally, as you would for any event you promote.
- Further advertising is at your discretion.
- ACS will email your flyer to contact addresses in your region for which it has email addresses.
- During your event, please record match scores and the hometown of each entrant.
- It is **mandatory** at the end of your event that you or your tournament director take a **digital photo of the winner(s)**, and email the photo to jlewis@americancuesports.org
- You will be called after your event (usually the next day) by ACS to receive info for ACS writing a press release of your results.
- ACS will submit your results & photo to ALL billiard publications by email.
- **ASAP** after your event, please submit a check for **\$5/player (deducted from each entrant’s entry fee)** and completed “Computation Work Sheet & Check List” of forms to ACS. **Please also include a list of all entries, as they are eligible for an end-of-year \$1,000 Lucasi Hybrid Cue raffle offered by Ozone Billiards.**
- If 32 or fewer entrants, the highest-placing ACS member receives a free 2010 ACS Nationals 9-ball singles entry. // If 33 or more entrants, the highest-placing ACS member receives a free 2010 ACS Nationals 8-ball singles entry.
